### Please read in its entirety:

The Prospect Summer Camp begins on Monday, June 23rd (off Friday July 4th) and runs for six weeks ending on Friday, August 1<sup>st</sup>.

Camp begins at 8:30am and runs until 2:30pm, Monday through Thursday at Community Center and Canfield Park. Extended care until 4pm Monday – Thursday. On Friday's campers will travel to different destinations; each week their pick up time will be adjusted; parents will be notified of the time change.

There will be no extended care on Fridays.

#### PLANNING/PREPARING:

Drop off and pick up will be in the rear of the building. All of those dropping off or picking up MUST remain in their vehicle. At which time a camp staff member will approach the car to take attendance of the child being dropped off. Drop Off location will be the rear of the Community Center. Signs will be posted.

If arriving after scheduled drop off or looking to pick your camper up before dismissal, please report to the Community Center main office to sign in and sign out.

If there is someone else who will be expected to pick up your camper please take the time to fill out the alternate transportation form located on the last page of the handbook.

- Those that feel sick or ill should stay home.
- <u>Sun Screen:</u> Please remember to apply sunscreen to your campers in the morning before attending camp and send them with additional **spray on sunscreen**. Counselors have been informed not to apply sunscreen to campers. However, if you send them with a spray bottle counselors will assist your camper to reapply. Remember this camp is mainly outdoors, sunscreen for a camper is recommended.
- <u>Dress Attire:</u> Campers should wear sneakers and comfortable clothes to camp each day. **No Open Toed Shoes.**
- Epi-Pens / Inhalers: If your child needs to bring an Epi-Pen or inhaler to camp, please follow these rules. Bring the pen/inhaler with you and bring it home each day. Place in a ZipLoc bag that contains your child's name, address, phone number, emergency phone number, list of allergies (if Epi-Pen), and a picture of your child. Please give this to the Camp Director upon arrival. Should your camper need to use their Epi-Pen, the counselors will assist in administering it. Parents will then be contacted for further instruction. However, if the child needs to be rushed to the hospital, an ambulance will be called.
- <u>Valuables:</u> Please leave all valuables including Cell Phones, Radios, electronic games, trading cards, key chains, and toys at home. Prospect Parks and Recreation Department is not responsible for any valuables lost, stolen, or damaged.

• <u>Lunch:</u> will be taken at a designated time for each group. At that time campers will go to their assigned areas within their group.

Campers should bring a bagged lunch, snack, and water with them each day to camp.

Please do not pack your child's lunch / snack with any nut/peanut products.

#### Field Trips

- Each Friday, Campers will travel to different destinations. Campers must arrive at Community School Parking lot at 8:30am. Parents can expect to pick up their campers later on these days. Trips are not optional. If your child does not want to go on that trip, there will be no camp offered that day.
- \*Please check your online account that you will be accepting text message updates. This will help with notifications of a bus delay for pick-up and other camp information.\*
- Campers that attend these trips must go and return on that bus! No one will be allowed to go home from the trip with parents or friends.

NOTE: There are three trips that require waivers those are R&B Sports World, Urban Air, and Xtreme Play. Please check make sure to fill all waivers out prior to attending camp that week. • Note: When attending these destinations, it is the parent's discretion to provide their campers with additional funds for games and such.
